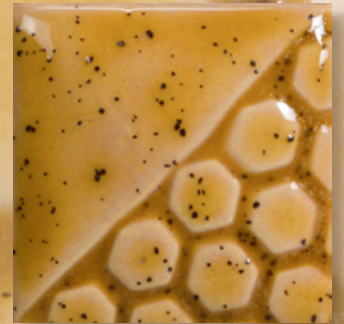




LOW-FIRE COMBO

Technique was achieved by brushing on two (2) layers of base glaze (EL-107 Amber Ash). Then apply two (2) layers of top glaze, letting glazes dry between coats.
